

USE OF COURTS:

As we only have six courts, members are requested to use common sense and extend courtesy to others in use of the courts, if other members are waiting to play. For example where members are waiting for a court, players already on the courts should limit their playing time, and play doubles rather than singles.

MEMBERS IDENTIFICATION:

Members are required to wear their Liston tennis shoe tags whenever they use the courts. These tags have been introduced as a means of ready identification of members in an attempt to prevent unauthorised use of the courts.

YOUNG CHILDREN:

Young children must be kept off the court area for their own safety, and must be under supervision at all times when they are at the Club's facilities.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE:

Members must take good care of the Club's facilities, and ensure that the Clubhouse kitchen area in particular is kept clean and tidy. All rubbish must be placed in the bins provided and members are requested to take home all clothing and other items brought to the Club. Remember it is your Club, and any extra expense incurred in maintaining the Club facilities in a clean and tidy condition has to be passed on to members through their membership fee. This particularly applies to rubbish removal, where the Club has incurred increased expenses in disposing of rubbish left at the Club.

CLUB MANAGEMENT AND CONTACT POINTS:

A Committee of Management elected annually from Club members administers the Club. All membership and other enquires should be directed through the Club Secretary (Alan Whittington) Ph: 0439 018 199 in the first instance although any Committee member is available to answer queries.

SUMMARISED LIST OF INFORMATION AND RULES

MEMBERSHIP:

All players other than visitors must be financially paid up members of the Club to play on Liston's courts. Liston offers various categories of membership (refer separate schedule). Membership confers the right to play on the courts at all times during the day except when the courts are required for competition play, tournament play, or coaching. Members must produce their membership card on request to any Committee member, or Club representative.

A member must accompany visitors, and the visitor/s details (name and date) must be entered in the Club Visitor's Register. The requisite visitor's fee (currently \$5 per Senior/Junior visitor) must be paid BEFORE COMMENCING PLAY and can be deposited in the slot of the Office/Store door. The same visitor is only permitted to play on the Courts a maximum of three (3) times in any one Club financial year (1 September to 31 August). Members are responsible at all times for the conduct of their guests.

FACILITIES KEY and LOCKING UP:

To obtain entry when the courts are locked, members must show their membership card to Hobson's Choice Cafe located directly opposite the Courts in Nelson Place. The keys must be returned IMMEDIATELY after gaining entry to the Club's facilities. The last member to leave the Club must ensure that all facilities (e.g. oven, air-con / heater, and lights) are switched off, and the both the Clubhouse door and the Court gate are locked.

STANDARD OF DRESS:

Members and visitors must wear proper tennis attire at all times when using the club's facilities. In particular, only non-marking tennis shoes are permitted on the Club courts.

COMPETITIONS:

The Club offers members the opportunity to participate in a wide range of competitions. These include Junior Western Region Tennis Association (WRTA) winter and summer competitions (played on Saturday mornings), Senior WRTA winter and summer competitions (played on Saturday afternoons), night competitions (played Tuesday & Wednesday weeknights) Tennis Victoria Pennant (played over the winter months) and Mid-week Ladies on Tuesday mornings. For Club representatives on any of the above competitions, please contact the Club Secretary. To play in any of the above competitions, a player must be a financial Club member.

NIGHT TENNIS:

The Club has all six courts available to members for night tennis (subject to competition and coaching requirements). A separate fee in addition to the Club membership fee is payable for night tennis. Current night tennis fees are \$12 per hour per court for non-competition play. Lights are operated via coin in the slot timers. \$2 coins are required to operate the lights

COACHING:

The Club has a professional Coach (Dane Nebel) who is a Registered TCAV Coach. Dane and his staff offer coaching on both an individual or group basis, over both day and night time sessions. All arrangements for coaching should be arranged directly with the Club Coach, because although Dane is a member of Liston's Committee of Management, he conducts his coaching business independently from the Club.
